**Title:** The title should be as brief as possible but long enough to indicate clearly the nature of the abstract. If you wish to include a subtitle, it must be included in this field and included in the 50-word limit.

### Abstract body (max 250 words)

To include the headings: Background and aims; Methods; Results; and Conclusions:

### Tips on writing your abstract

You should consider the following:

- What data to include
- How the data is best presented
- How to introduce your work
- How to link your research to practice
- All presenters must be registered to attend the conference. Abstract acceptance will be subject to registration for the conference. If your abstract is accepted for a presentation, you will need to register by no later than Friday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024. Presenters who fail to register by the due date risk having their presentation removed from the program.
- Please remember that submitting an abstract does NOT automatically register you as a conference delegate. Conference registration can be completed online at any time.
- All communications about your abstract will be sent to the email address you submit.
